**YOU HAVE MADE THE MOST IMPORTANT DECISION OF YOUR LIFE**—at a moment in time you believed in Jesus Christ as your Savior, the perfect Person judged as a substitute for your sins. From that instant of faith alone in Christ alone, you have eternal life and share the destiny of Christ.

For God so loved the world that He gave His uniquely born Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. (John 3:16)

Heaven is guaranteed to every believer (1 Peter 1:4–5). But the quality and impact of the believer's life on earth depend on his execution of God's plan after salvation.

When God commands you to "let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus," He wants you to renew your mind with divine viewpoint so that His gracious purpose can be fulfilled (Romans 12:2; Philippians 2:5, KJV).

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen. (2 Peter 3:18)

You are kept alive on earth to fulfill your personal destiny in God's plan—to become a mature believer as an expression of God's glory in both time and eternity. Only as a mature believer can you consistently glorify God and receive the highest and best that He has prepared (Ephesians 1:3–6). To reach that objective, you must learn, think, and apply Bible doctrine to the circumstances of life. And in doing so, you will gain capacity for life, for love, for Christian service, for blessings, and for happiness.

Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy, to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen. (Jude 24–25)



**Doctrine is built upon doctrine.** Often a single word can bring to mind eternal principles of God's wisdom and grace. For this reason, Pastor Thieme's approach to doctrinal teaching always emphasized the power of vocabulary. Rebound, faith-rest, dispensations, hypostatic union, protocol, divine dynasphere—these are words designed to be learned, understood, and integrated into the Christian's thinking.

Now, drawn from Thieme's personal notes and sermons, *Thieme's Bible Doctrine Dictionary* presents over eight hundred terms and related doctrines. Within the 320-page dictionary are concise explanations of the vocabulary, biblical metaphors, and practical illustrations taught in Bible class. 
# Publication Summaries

**Dying Grace** God has designed dying to be an extraordinary experience for believers in Jesus Christ. Spiritually mature believers, comforted and encouraged by the doctrine in their souls, walk their final journey with no regrets and eagerly anticipate meeting the Lord face to face.



**The Faith-Rest Life** is a life of moment-by-moment peace. In pressure, adversity, even disaster, God demands that His children do one thing—trust Him! Believe His Word! Mix His promises with faith! If you have trusted God for the greatest thing—salvation, then you can certainly trust Him for the lesser things—solutions to your problems.



**Follow the Colors** Military forces in the past used flags, or “colors,” to rally soldiers amidst combat confusion. The battle cry, “Follow the colors!” was the command to strike a blow against the enemy and fight to attain victory. Jesus Christ, our Supreme Commander, leads His Christian troops into spiritual warfare, unfurling the colors of Bible doctrine and calling for us to follow.



**Freedom through Military Victory** A strong military functioning under divine principles is necessary to preserve freedom and protect citizens within a nation. For the Christian soldier in harm’s way, or for any believer facing adversity, God provides spiritual problem-solving devices to alleviate anxiety and instill confidence in His everlasting care.



**Giving: Gimmick or Grace?** Giving is a form of worship that commemorates God’s grace. But without the correct spiritual motivation, giving is a gimmick inspired by guilt, approbation lust, or desire to manipulate God. This book draws on 2 Corinthians 8–9 to define the correct motivation for giving and to illustrate grace giving in the early Church.





**God the Holy Spirit vs. The Sin Nature** is a ceaseless inner conflict. Each Christian by his own volition determines who controls his life at any moment. The sin nature, inherent at birth, is a source of temptation for as long as we live—but with the power, mentorship, and guidance of the Holy Spirit, we have the spiritual dynamics to fulfill the Christian life.








**The Prodigal Son** left home and squandered his inheritance in riotous living. His elder brother stayed home and worked hard. When the prodigal returned and was restored to his father, the brother became petty, jealous, and resentful. Both sons were sinners, yet neither could be removed from his family relationship. Likewise, born-again believers, whether they sin like the prodigal or the self-righteous brother, are permanent members of God’s family.




**Psalms Twenty-Three** Written by David in his darkest despair, this song of hope holds a treasure of God’s grace for all believers. When fleeing for his life, David relied on the true Source of security and wrote, “The LORD is the one who keeps on shepherding me, I cannot and do not lack anything.” David’s journey through the death-shadowed valley demonstrates how a mature believer endures suffering and triumphs over his enemies.





**The Pursuit of Happiness** Scripture declares King Solomon "greater than all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom." From an ivory and gold throne he ruled Israel, all the while enriching his court with vast treasures and rare novelties. Yet Solomon did not have happiness. *The Pursuit of Happiness* confirms that only through fellowship with God and the pursuit of His Word can the believer attain true stability and contentment of soul.




**A Quartette of Fools** There is no more beautiful sound than four human voices in perfect harmony. Conversely, the most lugubrious ululations emanate from voices clashing in dissonance. Such is the quartette of fools: the atheist, the rich, the shameless, and the Christian fool. Three members cannot sing, cannot produce harmony, yet the fourth produces the finest sounds in the world! Find out where you fit into this quartette.



**Rebound and Keep Moving!** is the key to the Christian way of life. After salvation the sin nature remains a relentless adversary, tempting the believer to sin and live in carnality. When the believer sins, fellowship with God is lost—spiritual progress ceases. Yet by citing his sins to the Father, the believer is empowered to resume his advance in God's plan. This rebound procedure defeats guilt over past failures and opens the door to serving the Lord in the freedom of grace.



**Rebound Revisited** explores the divine directive for dealing with post-salvation sins and regaining momentum in the spiritual life. Rebound requires no emotional gimmicks—no feeling sorry for sins, no penance, no pleading with God for forgiveness. Recovery from carnality is not the work of man; it is the grace of God in action.



**Reversionism** Why do believers sometimes act like unbelievers? Anyone who accepts Jesus Christ is eternally saved, but the Christian who revolts against God's plan and lives in perpetual carnality reverts to spiritual decadence. In reversionism, true values are pushed aside and sin becomes a way of life. Yet God in His grace always provides the way of escape. The believer can recover from reversionism or avoid it altogether through rebound and consistent spiritual growth.

**Satan and Demonism** Demon activity has plagued mankind since the fall of Adam. Targeted at the human soul, invisible demonic attacks blind unbelievers to the Gospel, distract believers from the spiritual life, and threaten nations with divine judgment. How do people become entangled in demonism? Who can be demon possessed? How can believers protect themselves? The Bible reveals the answers and eliminates the confusion.




**Slave Market of Sin** We think of ourselves as free, but we are born into inescapable bondage. We enter the world with a sin nature, separated from God, powerless to establish a relationship with Him. However, the gracious plan of God calls for a savior, a redeemer—the Lord Jesus Christ—to purchase our freedom from the slave market.




**Tongues** Many believers today profess to speak a language they do not understand, claiming evidence of the indwelling Spirit. But the spiritual gift of tongues, while legitimate in the early Church, was discontinued once the written canon of Scripture was completed. In the postcanon Church, the Holy Spirit's ministry is unrelated to such practices. Our desire must be for sound doctrine, not the emotionalism of counterfeit miracles.




**The Trinity** is unique to Christianity. No other faith, religion, sect, or philosophy that advocates one God also proclaims that God is Three-in-One. This does not mean there are 'three gods in one' but that one God exists as three persons—all possessing the same essential nature. Each member of the Godhead has a distinct role, a specific purpose related to the eternal will and plan of God.




**The Unfailing Love of God** The Bible declares, "God is love"—love is what God is as well as what He does. Do you understand the magnitude of this love? Or is your concept of God's infinite love based on your own limited concept of human love? The love of God provides your salvation, motivates your spiritual growth, and secures your eternal future with Him. As you grow to understand God's love, you learn to reciprocate that love and increase your capacity to love other people.






**Victorious Proclamation** is history's most extraordinary testimony to the Gospel. Shortly after rising from the grave, Jesus Christ made "proclamation to the spirits in prison." These were the fallen angels of Genesis 6, Satan's demons imprisoned in the temporary "pits of darkness" in Hades. When His work of salvation was complete, the resurrected Christ appeared to them to announce His victory and confirm the defeat of their master, Satan.






